



CHIEF ENGINEER

Cole Harbour Place is a 200,000 square foot sport and recreation facility located in Cole Harbour, Nova Scotia. The facility includes pools, rinks, weight room and training centre, dance and fitness studios, spin studio, squash courts, various meeting rooms as well as multiple community minded tenants.

POSITION SUMMARY

As Chief Engineer you will be responsible to oversee the overall mechanical and electrical needs of the facility, while leading a team of dedicated employees in the Operations department. You will be responsible to recruit and train team members, oversee refrigeration plant operations, ensure safe work conditions, solve technical issues and assign tasks. The Chief Engineer works collaboratively with all members of the Cole Harbour Place leadership team to ensure our end users experience a facility that is safe, and in good repair.

The Chief Engineer is part of the Leadership team, and reports directly to the Building Director. This position requires full-time work, 40 hours per week, and must show a willingness to be flexible and work outside of regular hours.

DUTIES

- Responsible for the safe operation and possible repairs of the boiler plant, pool mechanical systems, air handling equipment, and refrigeration plant
- Select, schedule and train all employees in the safe operation of all mechanical systems
- Responsible for the ice grooming and ice maintenance program
- Responsible for the pool water treatment program
- Taking regular meter readings on designated equipment
- Responsible for the condition and possible repairs of all fixed installations, i.e. lights, doors, toilets, showers, arena fixtures etc
- Manage a team of unionized employees and evaluate staff performance
- Lead by example and assist staff in the daily performance of their duties
- Responsible for all general labour and preventative maintenance
- Oversee, promote and emphasize workplace safety
- On call for emergency situations
- Other duties or responsibilities may be assigned and added at managements discretion

- Second Class Refrigeration ticket or equivalent **required**
- Valid WHMIS certificate
- Must possess or be willing to obtain: CPR/First Aid, fall arrest, and lock out training
- Previous experience in a large facility is considered an asset
- Previous experience working within a unionized environment is considered an asset
- Previous work experience with pools, rinks and air handling units considered an asset
- Ability to work independently or as part of a team
- Demonstrate excellent verbal, written and oral skills
- Strong coordination and leadership skills
- Detail oriented with an ability to multi-task

- Willingness to do what it takes to get the job done
